About the Scholarship

Since 2003, Attorney Michael A. DeMayo has offered high school seniors a chance to win a scholarship toward their college education. When the program began 11 years ago, the firm awarded five \$1,000 scholarships to Mecklenburg County seniors who wrote essays on how our community could help curb underage drinking and driving. Over the past decade, the program has grown and evolved to include 15 winners across 23 counties who each receive a \$2,500 scholarship. In addition to writing an essay, students are also now able to express themselves through other media, including video, PowerPoint, web design or brochure design.

A \$2,500 scholarship can go a long way in helping pay for tuition, room and board, books and other materials necessary for an incoming college freshman. But it's more than an investment in things; it's an investment in our youth. Our firm has chosen this investment in our community so that all of us together can help prevent underage drinking and driving. We are proud to make a difference in our community by awarding \$230,000 in college scholarships to 102 deserving seniors in North and South Carolina since 2003. Good luck to all our applicants!

Instructions

All applications, transcripts, letters of recommendations, SAT/ACT scores and presentations MUST be received by the deadline in a **single package**. Items mailed separately will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Scholarships are judged and awarded without regard to race, gender, color, religion, creed, national origin, disability or sexual orientation.

Eligibility Criteria

• Must be a current high school (or home-schooled) senior who attends school and lives in the following counties:

North Carolina: Mecklenburg, Gaston, Catawba, Union, Cabarrus, Cleveland, Lincoln, Rowan, Caldwell, Stanly, Iredell, Alexander, Burke, Robeson, Scotland, Richmond, Anson and Cumberland

South Carolina: York, Lancaster, Chesterfield, Marlboro and Dillon

- Must be accepted for full-time enrollment or planning to pursue a degree at an accredited four-year college or university
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher

Deadline to Apply

All entries must be post-marked on or before midnight on **February 25, 2013** or dropped off at one of our four offices by 5 p.m., **February 25, 2013**. Entries sent by email will not be accepted. The Law Offices of Michael A. DeMayo, L.L.P. will not be responsible for any late, lost or damaged entries.

Entering the Contest

High school seniors must return the following items to our office in a single package:

- 1. Scholarship application (typed, neatly printed or computer generated). A recent photo of yourself must be attached to the application.
- 2. A presentation (video/PowerPoint/brochure/website/essay) that encourages fellow teens to abstain from underage drinking and driving and/or highlights the dangers of drinking and driving.
- 3. Official or unofficial high school transcript (must include class rank, size and test scores).
- 4. SAT or ACT scores (if not included in transcript, a printout from CollegeBoard.com is acceptable).
- 5. Two letters of recommendation (from teachers, athletic coaches, school administrators, club advisors, volunteer work supervisors, employers, religious leaders or family friends). Letters of recommendation should assess the applicant's academic potential, his/her progress and academic achievements, community/school involvement or volunteer activities.

Types of Acceptable Presentations

Thousands of alcohol-related automobile accidents occur every year, and teens have higher than average alcohol-related injuries and deaths when compared to other age groups. The Law Offices of Michael A. DeMayo invites high school seniors to develop a unique, and compelling presentation that encourages fellow teens to abstain from underage drinking and driving and/or highlights the dangers of underage drinking and driving. Presentations may be in the form of:

Video

Public Service Announcement (no more than 60 seconds); Must be recorded on DVD; students name and school should appear directly on DVD; must provide copy of script.

PowerPoint

15 slide minimum - Also must provide copy of PowerPoint on CD/DVD, as well a hard copy of color slides. Student's name and school should appear directly on CD/DVD.

Brochure/Booklet

8 page minimum - Also must provide copy of brochure/booklet on CD/DVD, as well as a hard copy printed in color. Student's name and school should appear directly on CD/DVD.

Website

10 page minimum - Also must provide copy of website on CD/DVD or link to website, as well as a hard copy printed in color. Student's name and school should appear directly on CD/DVD.

Essay

750-1,000 words - Must be typed and double-spaced.

Selection of Winners

A panel of judges representing the Law Offices of Michael A. DeMayo will choose 15 winners. The Scholarship Committee will consider these criteria in making their selection: academic achievement; letters of recommendation; SAT or ACT scores; community and school involvement; and presentation. The presentations will be judged on students' abilities to analyze and discuss the topic and produce a quality video/PowerPoint/brochure/website/essay.

The decision of the judges will be final. Each scholarship recipient will be notified by telephone no later than 5 p.m. Monday, April 8, 2013. Applicants who are not selected will receive a letter in the mail. Entries will be disqualified if they contain vulgar or inappropriate content; are not turned in with all the proper paperwork; have postmarks later than Monday, February 25, 2013; use copyrighted materials; or use content that has not been properly cited.

Number of Awards

Fifteen winners will each receive a \$2,500 scholarship to the college/university of their choice. Odds of winning a prize depends on the number of entries received.

Method of Disbursement

Awards are paid in one installment. Checks will be made out to the student and the school they are attending. Checks will be presented to students at a scholarship dinner Michael A. DeMayo will host for the students and their parents.

Ownership of Entries

All entries submitted to the Law Offices of Michael A.
